



Our fly food is made by the Media Preparation & Decontamination Facility at the Faculty of Life Sciences.

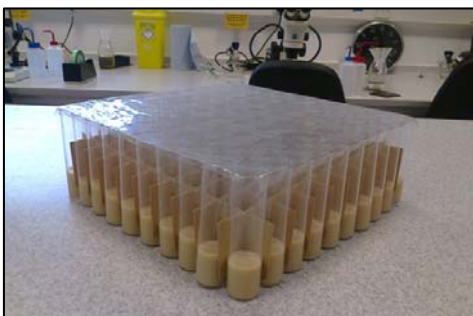
Our Fly Food is packaged and transported to you in reinforced cardboard boxes. Each box contains 5 cardboard trays of fly food with each tray holding 100 vials of fly food (10x10 configuration).

Each tray of fly food is dated on the day it was filled and can be used for up to 3 months after this date.

We use polystyrene vials supplied by Dutscher Scientific that are safe to use and have a glass-like clarity.



Each tray of fly food is enclosed in a sealable plastic bag to maintain freshness and provide a further protection against contamination with flies once the tray is starting to be used.



Our fly food vials are sealed airtight with sticky plastic film to prevent dehydration and keep the food sterile. This allows the long storage time.



They are delivered upside-down so they can be pulled one-by-one off the plastic film – easy to use.
